





BOYHOOD

For 35 years, Bob wore the title of Co- Founder, CEO, and Board Chair of Express Employment Professionals.

Bob's leadership (and investment in brand and people) become known throughout the Staffing Industry as well as the worldwide Franchising Community as Express reached record sales in 2018 of \$5.6 Billion and employed 560,000 people. Since awarding its first Express franchise in 1985, the staffing company grew to more than 815 franchises with nearly 7,500 staff members in the U.S., Canada and South Africa.

Known to have entrepreneurial spirit, Bob personally owns 43 Express offices in Oklahoma, Texas, Arkansas and Kansas while staying active in leadership with other Express affiliated companies like Express Ranches, The Express Clydesdales, Express Sports, Funk Companies and Express Travel Service.



HORSEMAN

Bob was honored for more than two decades of achievement with an induction into the Clydesdale Hall of Fame in 2019 by the Clydesdale Breeders of the U.S.A.

Lisa Graham, a former board member and spokeswoman for the Clydesdale organization, called Bob a tireless supporter of the Clydesdale industry with accomplishments that go well beyond the numerous national awards and world championships that his horses have won.

A great patriot and advocate for freedom, faith and American values, Bob has been called upon to speak at university commencements, state-wide leadership conferences and to personally escort Prince William and Kate in the Calgary Parade.

CATTLEMAN

Growing up with farm work ethics, Bob enthusiastically set out to change the North American cattle industry.

In 1996, Bob joined Jarold Callahan to launch Express Ranches which became ranked as the largest seedstock operation in America based upon sales records compiled by Cattle-Fax and published by National Cattlemens' Beef Association (NCBA). Impressively, Express Ranches feeds as many as 50,000 head of cattle each year. In addition to its bull sales each spring and fall, Express Ranches is among the industry's largest sources of bulls sold at private treaty.

Bob's achievements and leadership led to meaningful honors and recognition.

Bob's achievements in the staffing industry earned him induction into the International Franchise Association (IFA) Hall of Fame in 2010. He was recognized in 2013 as Most Admired CEO by The Journal Record and in 2014 recognized by Oklahoma State University Division of Agriculture Sciences and Natural Resources with their Champion Award. In 2015, Bob was recognized as Man of the Year by IMPACT OKC Magazine. He is a member and former chairman of the Greater Oklahoma City Chamber and current chairman of the Oklahoma Youth Expo.

Due to his vast achievements and contributions, Bob was one of eight inductees into the Oklahoma Hall of Fame in 2017 presented by actor and friend Tom Selleck.



SPORTSMAN


Being a top athlete and league champion in tennis and basketball, Bob always loved sports.

Knowing the power of athletics, Bob helped brand the re-birth of Oklahoma City through a variety of investments including being the co-owner of Texas Rangers' Triple-A franchise Redhawks Baseball, Oklahoma City Blazers Hockey, Oklahoma City Barons Hockey and OKC Energy FC Soccer. And his contributions to Oklahoma State University Cowboys amass the largest contributions in university history as a non-alumnus.


